

Featuring Adrianne Sequeira, RN, RP, MDiv, DMin (candidate), Registered Psychotherapist, Certified Psychoanalyst, Family and Addiction Counsellor. Four major mental health/psychiatric modules in Substance Related Disorders, Mood Disorders, Anxiety and Trauma Related Disorders and Psychotic Disorders are covered. Individuals will learn to recognize symptoms of mental illnesses and will develop skills to deal with emergencies in each of the above four categories.
