

To register now, you must come to the parish office. Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm

Registration will be closed after October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Parents <u>must</u> come to the registration. A copy of the Baptismal Certificate for all students who are participating in the First Communion or Confirmation programs *is required in order to register*. Fees: \$150 for students in the First Communion/First Reconciliation sacramental preparation and \$150 for students in the Confirmation sacramental preparation and \$75 for all other students - cash or cheque - payable to Blessed Sacrament Church.
