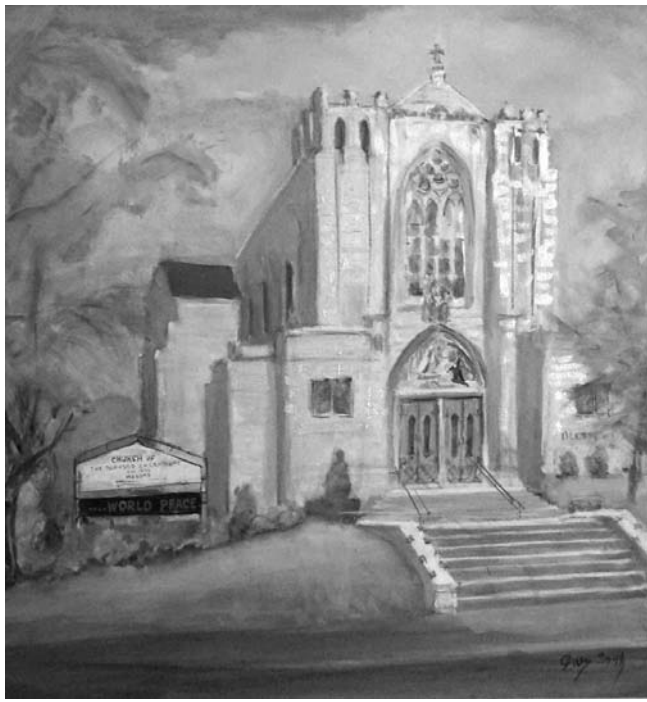

**Sunday, October 4 - 2:00 - 3:00 pm** - Life Chain is a peaceful and silent witness to the injustice of abortion and the harm it inflicts on women and the community at large. It is a simple but powerful reminder to our fellow citizens of the sanctity of human life and our duty to defend the weakest members of our society.

The very first Life Chain was held in 1987 in Yuba City, California and consisted of 2,500 people. The annual event grew by leaps and bounds in the following years, with Canada holding its first Life Chain in 1990, and almost 1,000,000 participating across North America in 1992. Last year, there were over 250 Life Chains in Canada and over 15,000 are estimated to have participated from coast to coast.

This year, we will be marking 30 years of Life Chain in Canada. Most Life Chains will be held on Sunday, October 4th. Our nearest Life Chain is Avenue Road and Wilson or Yonge and Eglinton. [www.campaignlifecoalition.com/life-chain](http://www.campaignlifecoalition.com/life-chain).

**The PAG Giving** – Parishioners have the option to give their offertory via the Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) program.
