

We have begun our spiritual Lenten journey Let us remember that this Holy Season requires us to increase our prayer time, to be reconciled with Christ and our Neighbour, and to look after the needs of the Poor. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we are required to fast and abstain from meat. We also abstain from meat on all Friday during Lent. Please join us for Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent at 7:00 pm. As you see, the purple colour of penance is found in the church sanctuary and no flowers are displayed.

Know How to Suffer and Be Stronger Than Suffering - The Evangelist Luke through Peter on Pentecost Day reveals what went on in the secret of Jesus' heart as he hung agonizing on the cross (Acts 2:25-28). We will trace the theme of suffering in the Holy Scriptures and reflect on the seven spiritual goods into which we can transform our suffering. We will end with a reflection on Mary's and Jesus' suffering through the narration of the Evangelist Luke. We will also present an example of a very holy woman who lived in our Archdiocese of Toronto, whose cause for beatification is now in Rome and who like Jesus' was stronger than suffering.
