

#### Communion Reflection: The gift of sight ....

Helen Keller, who went blind and deaf at nineteen months said:

"One day I asked a friend of mine who had just returned from a long walk in the woods what she had seen. She replied, "nothing in particular." How can this be possible? I asked myself, when I, who cannot hear or see, find hundreds of things to interest me through mere touch. I feel the delicate shape and design of a leaf. I pass my hands lovingly over the rough bark of a pine tree. Occasionally, I place my hand quietly on a small tree, and if I'm lucky, feel the happy quiver of a bird in full song. The greatest calamity that can befall people, is not that they should be born blind, but that they should have eyes, yet fail to see.
