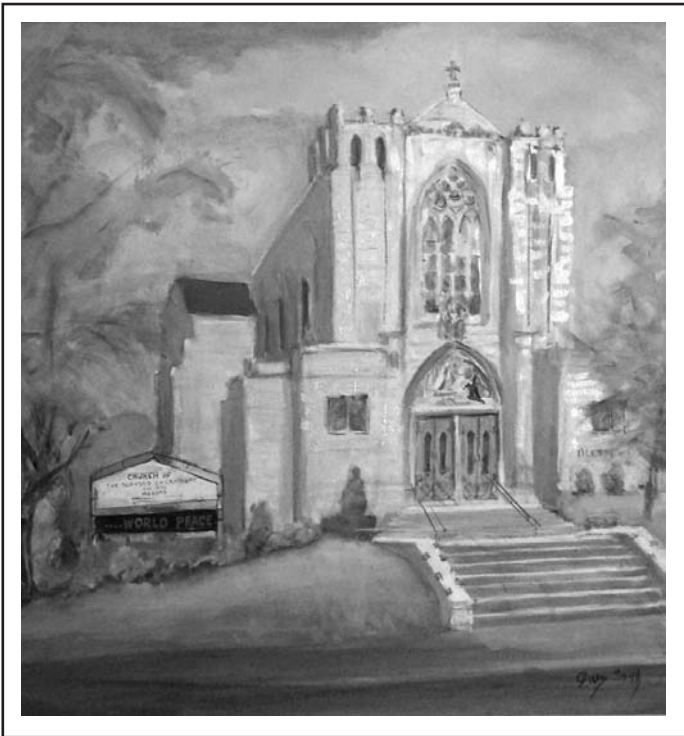

Forgiveness

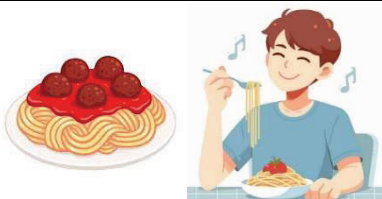
Forgiveness is like the child's dream of a miracle.
