

Ash Wednesday March 5th

Ash Wednesday begins the forty days of Lent. We practice prayer, fasting and sacrifice on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we fast and abstain from meat. Catholics who are 18-58 years old are required to keep a limited fast. A single normal meal and two snacks. Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain from eating meat. Mass with the imposition of ashes will be celebrated at the following times:

8:30 am, 12:00 pm, 1:00 pm (school Mass) and 7:00 pm.
