

Communion Reflection Quotes

Fron St. Theresa of Lisieux: If I have hardly any bread in my sack, he knows and takes care of it himself. This is the true meaning of the Eucharist – that He is here, with us. As she once wrote in a letter to a friend, "Oh, my darling, think, then, that Jesus is there in the Tabernacle expressly for you, for you alone."

From St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta: "The Holy Eucharist is the spiritual food that sustains me – without the Eucharist, I could not get through one single day or hour in my life." Visitors to her home for the dying in Calcutta were often surprised that their first stop was the Eucharistic chapel.

Fron St Augustine: "What you see is the bread and the chalice; that is what your own eyes report to you. But what your faith obliges you to accept is that the bread is the body of Christ, and the chalice is the Blood of Christ.
