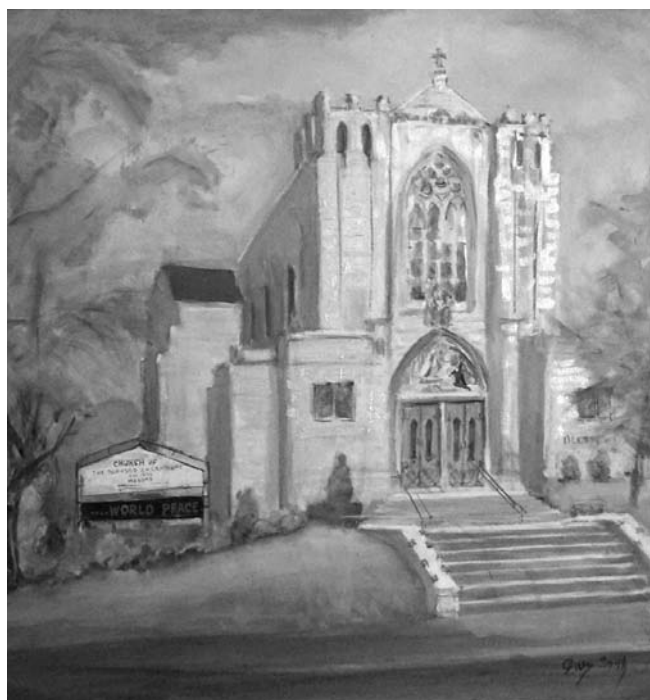

the Indigenous Community. THANK YOU.

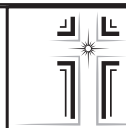
A Young Adult Youth Group ages 19 – 35 years

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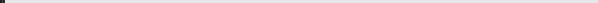
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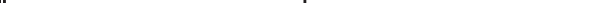
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
