

Communion Reflection

The beatitudes are the badges of a true disciple of Christ.

They are the marks of a child of God.

They make us rich in the sight of God.

They open our minds and hearts to a new way of seeing and judging. They give us a whole new set of bearings. The things the beatitudes stand for are very beautiful and very precious – things such as peace, goodness, joy, love, gentleness, compassion, mercy, integrity.

A person who lives according to the beatitudes is already in the kingdom of heaven. Eternal life will merely be the full blossoming of a plant that is green with life.

February 3rd – Feast of Saint Blaise: the martyred Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia, reputed to have miraculously saved the life of a choking young boy. It is customary to bless the throats of the faithful on this day to preserve them from illnesses of the throat. Throats will be blessed at the end of Mass on Tuesday, February 3rd.
